Stephen Jewell Carr came to Norman, December 4, 1920, when he enlisted in the U. S. Army and was assigned to the R.O.T.C. (Reserve Officers Training Corps) at the University of Oklahoma. He spent 23 years of his 30 years in the Army at the University; the other 7 years were spent in Texas during World War II, and in Korea. He rejoined the army as a Private and retired in 1950 with the rank of Major. Upon retirement, he was employed by the University in a civilian capacity as assistant Military Property Custodian. He retired from Oklahoma University in 1967. He now has a real estate business, and is raising cattle and farming on his 20 acres east of Noble near Maguire Store. He lives at 1505 Ann Arbor Drive.

the Scout Master of Troop 6, then 46, then 246 of the First Nazarene Church for 42 years, first starting the troop in the old sandstone church in 1928. In 1937, he received the highest scouting award for service by the Last Frontier Council, The Silver Beaver Award.

Stephen was one of five children born to Jewell Waller Carr, 1875-1905, and Arlie Belle Davis Carr, 1895-1927, in Young County, Texas. Jewell Waller Carr's parents were Jesse D. Carr and Henrietta Craig Carr, from Kentucky. Arlie Davis Carr's parents were Stephen Decatur Carr and Margaret Matthews Davis, from Tennessee. The Davis forebears came over from England in the early 1700's, before the Revolution, and settled in Virginia.

Stephen Carr came to Norman from Vici, near Gage and Woodward, Oklahoma. Stephen's father was thrown from a horse and killed in 1905. His mother married Henry Vestal Peek, a school teacher. There were five children born to this union. When Arlie Davis Carr Peek died, in 1927, two of the younger children, Archie Dillard Peek and Henry Lawrence Peek came to Norman to live with their brother, Stephen, and to attend high school and the University of Oklahoma
